Different forms.

Same return.

How the encounter enters rooms.

15-20 MIN	<i>Keynote</i>	A focused interruption.
30-45 MIN	<i>Extended Keynote</i>	More space for internal decision.
45-60 MIN	<i>Workshop</i>	Guided naming of the next movement.
60-90 MIN	<i>Voice Experience</i>	A slower, immersive encounter.
30-45 MIN	<i>Lunch & Learn</i>	Practical, accessible for teams.
60-90 MIN	<i>Leadership Session</i>	Restoring movement around what matters.
HALF-DAY	<i>Retreat Session</i>	Space for reset and recommitment.
ADAPTABLE	<i>Faith or Corporate</i>	Same human tension.
